#### What to Wear

- All dancers will wear their holiday showcase t-shirt and BLACK leggings (females) or BLACK pants (males).
   They will also need to wear the required footwear for each style of dance they are performing in (ballet shoes, tap shoes, jazz shoes etc.).
- Dancers may choose to wear holiday accessories with their outfit, including but not limited to:
  - Holiday socks
  - Holiday headbands (as long as they can perform with no issues)
  - Holiday necklaces/other jewelry EXCEPT dangly earrings.

### **Makeup Recommendations**

- Makeup is recommended for all dancers so that the audience can see their face on stage. Please
  take time to do your dancer's makeup carefully and practice before the show to reduce stress on
  show day.
- <u>Dancers under age 5</u> only need pink blush and brick-red lipstick (not cherry!).
- <u>Dancers ages 6-8</u> are recommended to wear eyeshadow, blush and lipstick.
- <u>Dancers ages 8+</u> are recommended to wear full stage makeup, including foundation, mascara and eyeliner.
- Eyeshadow recommendation: Maybelline Eyeshadow Natural Smokes Link on Amazon
- Blush recommendation: Covergirl Cheekers #110 Classic Pink Link on Amazon
- Lipstick recommendation: Maybelline Superstay Lipstick #50 Voyager Link on Amazon
- Please fill in eyebrows.
- You will feel like you are putting a lot of makeup on your child's face and that is normal. You want them to be seen!

### **Required Hairstyle**

Hair must be secured in a slicked back (with gel and hairspray) mid-level ponytail:

- A mid-pony is on the crown of the head, not the nape and not above the ears.
- The ponytail should not be visible from the front of your dancer.
- Parting the hair is optional.
- Please do not braid the ponytail!
- You may choose to accessorize with a scrunchie, headband etc. but please do not use butterfly clips, as they can slip out of the hair while dancing.



#### **Tickets**

- <u>All patrons will have ASSIGNED SEATING</u>. Tickets are a flat rate of \$10 + taxes and fees online. Tickets will be \$16 at the door and assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. It is recommended that you purchase all tickets online ahead of show day!
- Tickets will be sold online through our ticketing website and are currently available for purchase.
- All patrons over age 2 must have a ticket to enter the theatre. Children age 2 and under can sit on the lap of their adult.
- Tickets are non-refundable.
- PLEASE READ: To avoid distractions to our viewing audience, we ask that you remain seated for the duration of the show except for emergent situations only. We will have one ten-minute intermission halfway between the show. This is a great time to use the restroom before returning to your seat for the second act. All dancers are required to stay for the duration of the show and will participate in the final bow.

#### **Merchandise**

- We will have some fun new PDC branded merchandise available for sale when you order your tickets online, and on Showcase Day. Pre-ordered merch will be available for pick up at Will Call.
- If you want to purchase on-site, we encourage that you come early for best selections as merchandise is sold on a first come, first serve basis!

















## **Dressing Room Drop-Off & Pick-Up Information**

- SAFETY PLAN IN EFFECT! As part of our ongoing commitment to health and safety, PDC has reviewed all of our policies this year and have made some updates and improvements to our Recital Safety Plans. Our drop off and pick up procedures reflect our commitment to ensuring that all of our dancers are safe during our Recitals. We ask you to trust that we have put a lot of thought into these procedures and ask you for your full review & compliance.
- Dressing Room DROP OFF: Please plan to have one parent drop off your dancer. This parent will check in at the check-in table to confirm your dressing room assignment. You will be given a card with your dancer's name on the back of it. Please keep it safe as it will be what you need to pick up your dancer at the conclusion of the performance. Once you drop your dancer off, you will need to leave the drop off hallway unless you are a registered volunteer. NO PARENTS, other than registered volunteers or faculty members, are permitted in the dressing rooms during the performances.
- Dressing Room PICK UP: Please send only one parent to the dressing room to pick up your dancer.
   ALL dancers will be kept safely in the dressing room and backstage area until a parent has picked
   them up. Please form a line in the hallway. You will need to present your dancers card to the
   dressing room volunteer in order to pick up your dancer. This procedure applies to all dancers
   age 12 and under.
- Changing in the Dressing Rooms: Because there are no costume changes with this show, dancers will only need assistance with changing shoes. We have a large team of staff and volunteers who will be in the dressing rooms to assist your dancer(s) with any needs they might have. These volunteers will be well-trained and will help keep your dancer safe and on time. NO PARENTS, other than registered volunteers or faculty members, are permitted in the dressing rooms during the performances.
- Once the performance begins, all dancers must remain backstage in their assigned dressing room until the conclusion of the performance. Our parent volunteer team will assist with any needs they might have and ensure their safety to and from the stage. At the end of the show, the Pick-Up Policy will be in effect for getting your dancers from the backstage area.
- We will have activities for our youngest dancers available to them during their waiting time in the
  dressing room. This will include a movie, coloring books/crayons, board games etc. Please do not
  send your dancer with a personal tablet, as PDC cannot be responsible for lost or damaged items.
  Older dancers can bring electronics or other activities, but keep in mind that access to WiFi is
  limited and may not be available in the dressing rooms.
- Water bottles can be brough into the dressing room, but no other food or drinks are allowed.
